NOTES

Since 1985, the Iain Rennie Hospice at Home has cared for 7,000 terminally ill patients and their families across the Chilterns area.



Our pioneering service began in 1985 when five nurses helped our first patient, Iain Rennie, to come home from hospital to be with his young family during the final stages of his battle with cancer. More than 20 years later, the Hospice At Home charity that proudly bears Iain's name still holds fast to the values that made a difference for him and his family.

Our belief in offering practical, hands-on nursing care at home for our patients, combined with support for their families and access to a 24 hour on-call nursing service is as strong as ever. Through fundraising and donations, we have also been able to ensure that the service is still offered completely free of charge to patients of any age with any terminal diagnosis.



Our greatest challenge is to ensure that we can continue to meet the need for the professional nursing care we give to patients coping with cancer and other life threatening illnesses, in their own homes. We can only do this with financial support and practical help from the communities we serve across Bucks and Herts. This is why we need you to play your part.
