- NOTES
1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Iain Rennie Hospice at Home (IRHH).
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the IRHH reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the IRHH reclaims, you should cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask IRHH. Or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
