Fundraising Tips



Getting started



First of all, decide what kind of **Chilterns Big Brew** you would like to hold. You could organise a Classic Tea Party, a Royal Street Party, Children's Prince and Princess Fancy Dress Tea Party, Victorian Tea Party, Cup Cake Tea Party, Champagne and Strawberries Tea Party, Classic Garden Party, or hold a mini beer festival or ale tasting party and get your local pub involved.

There are many different ways to enjoy a good brew, but all of them will help us carry on caring.

Once you have decided on your event and chosen a date and time, the next step is to find the best venue. Many of our supporters will hold their events at home or in the garden, or you could hire a local village hall or ask your WI or local pub to help out. We can provide you with extra flyers and posters to help publicise your event, and local papers always like a good story too!

On the day, don't be afraid to ask for help. Why not ask friends and family to help bake cakes, make tea or pick strawberries? Always make sure you have enough volunteers to help with the washing up afterwards too!

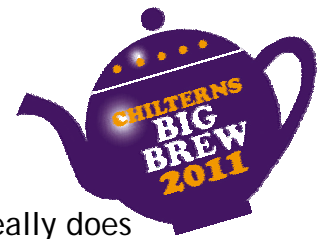


Making the most out of your event

There are lots of ways to raise extra pennies at your tea party. As well as asking for **donations** for tea and cakes, you could organise a raffle and ask local companies, friends, families and parents to donate prizes. Or, why not hold an **auction of "promises"** and ask friends and family to think of a promise they can auction, such as mowing the lawn, doing the ironing or walking the dog for a month! Another fun way is to theme your prizes to match your event.

You could hold a **recipe swap shop**, a **cup cake competition** or a **nearly new clothes and toys sale**. **Homemade goodies** always go down well, so ask friends to make jam, marmalade or cakes to sell on the day.

Every penny counts
